A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, FOR AN EMS PRIORITY ONE TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, provides grant funding to assist EMS organizations with the purchase of approved training and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, could provide EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant funding to assist with the purchase of training and/or equipment as approved by the Ohio Emergency Medical, Fire, and Transportation Services (EMFTS) Board in an amount to be determined, with no matching funds required; and

WHEREAS, applications for EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant funding are due by April 1, 2018, and the Ohio EMFTS Board will award grant funding in June, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's designee has submitted a grant application to increase the likelihood of receiving funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council hereby affirms the City Manager's designee's actions to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, for an EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
