

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE OF A SUSTAINABILITY GRANT DISBURSEMENT THROUGH THE ECOSMART CHOICE PROGRAM FROM AMERICAN MUNICIPAL POWER.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 16-100, passed by this Council on July 19, 2016, the City Manager entered into an Agreement with American Municipal Power ("AMP") to purchase renewable energy certificates and offer Hudson Public Power customers the option to participate in the AMP EcoSmart Choice Program; and

WHEREAS, AMP administers the Sustainability Grant Program, which returns unused program funds to participating members of the EcoSmart Choice Program to recognize their commitment to sustainability through the promotion of environmentally focused community-based grant projects; and

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2018, AMP awarded and the City Manager's designee accepted a 2017 Sustainability Grant in the amount of \$619.00 to fund the purchase of energy-efficient items to be used for giveaways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council hereby affirms the acceptance by the City Manager's designee of a 2017 Sustainability Grant from American Municipal Power in the amount of \$619.00 to fund the purchase of energy-efficient items to be used for giveaways.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
