

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND THE OHIO HIGHWAY PATROL, OHIO TRAFFIC SAFETY OFFICE/TRAFFIC RECORDS COORDINATING COMMITTEE, FOR A GRANT TO PROVIDE ELECTRONIC TABLETS FOR HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") and the Ohio Highway Patrol, Ohio Traffic Safety Office/Traffic Records Coordinating Committee have collaborated to distribute approximately 1,200 electronic tablets to EMS agencies throughout Ohio for the promotion of EMS data reporting submission to the Ohio EMS Incident Reporting System and for use with the OHTrac Mass Casualty Incident Mobile Application and Trauma Registry, and;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS and the Ohio Highway Patrol, Ohio Traffic Safety Office/Traffic Records Coordinating Committee could provide 10 iPads, valued up to approximately \$5,000.00 to be used by Hudson Emergency Medical Service for data reporting; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's designee submitted a Grant application for said purpose to the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS and the Ohio Highway Patrol, Ohio Traffic Safety Office/Traffic Records Coordinating Committee on March 6, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council hereby affirms the City Manager's designee's actions to execute and file a grant application with the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS and the Ohio Highway Patrol, Ohio Traffic Safety Office/Traffic Records Coordinating Committee for 10 iPads, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
