A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER TO THE SUMMIT/AKRON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY (dba REWORKS) FOR A COMMUNITY RECYCLING ACCESS GRANT TO SUPPORT RECYCLING SERVICES AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF SAID GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson desires to assist in implementing and supporting new and existing community recycling programs that assist the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority (the "Authority"), dba ReWorks, in meeting the goals and objectives of the State of Ohio's Solid Waste Management Plan and the Authority's approved Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has developed the Community Recycling Access Grant (the "Grant") to support projects which would sustain and increase recycling activities within Summit County, and the City has participated in that Grant program since 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager submitted an application for and has accepted award of said Grant in the amount of \$22,262.00 from the Authority to help defray the costs of contracted recycling services, contracted leaf collection services and related costs during the current calendar year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Council hereby supports and affirms the City Manager's action to submit an application to the Authority, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for funding assistance under the Grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.
- <u>Section 2</u>. Council hereby affirms the City Manager's acceptance of said Grant in the amount of \$22,262.00 for the reasons stated in the recitals of this Resolution.
- <u>Section 3</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
