

RESOLUTION NO. 18-59

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT WITH CATTS CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE VALLEY VIEW ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 17-153, adopted by this Council on October 3, 2017, the City Manager was authorized to advertise, bid, and award the Valley View Road Culvert Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, staff awarded the Valley View Road Culvert Replacement Project contract to Catts Construction, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that it is necessary to amend the aforesaid contract in accordance with the recommendation of the City Manager to authorize additional funds as a change order for the addition of work relating to unforeseen site conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: A change order in the amount of nine thousand dollars (\$9,000) to the Valley View Road Culvert Replacement Project contract with Catts Construction, Inc. is approved.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to complete the culvert replacement project at the earliest possible time for the safety of the motoring public and to do so during this construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
