

## **RESOLUTION NO. 18-67**

## A RESOLUTION THANKING MR. FRANK YOUNGWERTH FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE HUDSON COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, Frank Youngwerth and his family moved to Hudson in 1978; and since then, he has performed a variety of volunteer activities that have significantly benefited the community; and

**WHEREAS**, with Frank's extensive background in radio and television; he was a valuable member of the HCTV Advisory Committee from 1998 through 2004, and he served as Chairman of the Committee from 2000 through 2004; and

**WHEREAS,** Frank has solicited donations for HCTV since 2004, resulting in financial gifts in excess of \$50,000 that have been used to help underwrite production expenses for the station; and

**WHEREAS**, with Frank's passion for television programming, he has hosted and produced HCTV programming for the past 20 years; including hosting and production of "Good Day in Hudson" for the past 18 years and hosting programming for the Hudson Junior Golf Tournament from 1999 to 2012; and

WHEREAS, Frank was a member of the Hudson Bandstand Committee from 1985 to 2010; and he has announced the Summer Music Festival Concerts on the Green for 26 years; and

WHEREAS, Frank announced Hudson Basketball games for 25 years, and he was the Hudson Swing Marching Band announcer for 7 years; and

WHEREAS, Frank has hosted and produced the popular "Memory Lane" Program, featuring music and video from the 1920s through 1950s, at Laurel Lake for 21 years; and

**WHEREAS,** Frank has been a member of Holy Trinity Anglican Church choir for the past 14 years, and he has been the Chairman of the church's annual golf outing for 5 years; and

**WHEREAS,** it is the desire of the Mayor and Council to recognize Frank for his significant contributions and for his willingness to share his time, knowledge, and talents for the good of the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the City of Hudson, Ohio, on behalf of itself and the citizens of Hudson, expresses its sincere thanks and gratitude to Mr. Frank Youngwerth for 40 years of volunteer service to the Hudson community.
