

RESOLUTION NO. 18-70

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH SIRKOCH ASSOCIATES FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF MAJOR ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE PROSPECT STREET SUBSTATION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City's Hudson Public Power is in need of six (6) 7.62Kv distribution regulators and associated components for the completion the Prospect Street Substation Improvement Project, Phase 2; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 16-190, passed by this Council on December 6, 2016, the City recently advertised for and received competitive bids for said equipment; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that the bid of Sirkoch Associates, Moon Township, Pennsylvania, be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Sirkoch Associates as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Sirkoch Associates, Moon Township, Pennsylvania, for the purchase of six (6) 7.62Kv distribution regulators and associated components for the Prospect Street Substation Improvement Project in an amount not to exceed \$115,500.00, and as said amount has been appropriated in the City budget.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
