A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE OF A FIREFIGHTER EXPOSURE TO ENVIRONMENTAL ELEMENTS PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 18-72 on May 15, 2018, authorizing the City Manager or her designee to submit an application to the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for a Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Program Grant to help fund the purchase of forty (40) hoods with barrier protection to minimize firefighter exposure to dangerous environmental elements; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation has awarded Hudson Fire with said grant in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Program Grant requires a match from the City in the amount of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00); and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to affirm the acceptance of said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council affirms acceptance by the City Manager's designee of funding by the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for a Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Program Grant in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) with a match from the City in the amount of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) for the purpose set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
