A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF A POLICE / DISPATCH RADIO CONSOLE.

WHEREAS, it is essential to replace the current obsolete Zetron radio equipment that is currently installed at the Police Station; and

WHEREAS, the new equipment will replace the push-button radio equipment in dispatch with easily manageable flat panel screens, and includes two MCC7500, one MCC7500E for backup, implementation, and warranty services for 5-years; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter and state law, this Council has the authority by legislative enactment such as this Resolution to authorize a purchase of equipment through a competitive bid obtained through a cooperative purchasing program, which for this purchase is through Ohio State Term Schedule Contract 573077, with Motorola Solutions providing said radio equipment and services for the total price of \$487,922.00; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that the City enter into a purchase agreement with Motorola Solutions for said dispatch equipment; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to authorize said contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Motorola Solutions for new police/dispatch radio console in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars (\$487,922.00), and the contract shall be in a form acceptable to the City Manager and City Solicitor.
- Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>Section 3:</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
