

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE FLEET VEHICLES FOR POLICE OPERATIONS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter, Section 6.04 of Article VI, the City has the authority to purchase vehicles through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price from Cincy Autos, Inc. DBA Lebanon Ford, Lebanon, Ohio, under the State of Ohio Procurement State Term Schedule Contract No. RS901620 for three (3) 2020 Ford Utility Interceptor Vehicles in the amount of \$105,798.60 for Police Department operations for the purpose of replacing three (3) fleet vehicles at the end of their useful lives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Hudson a purchase agreement with Cincy Autos Inc. DBA Lebanon Ford, Lebanon, Ohio for three (3) 2020 Ford Utility Interceptor Vehicles for a total amount not to exceed One Hundred Five Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$105,798.60), which purchase amount is approved in the 2020 City Budget.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
