A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH WRIGHT LINE, LLC, FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE/DISPATCH RADIO CONSOLE FURNITURE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 19-162, passed by this Council on November 19, 2019, the City Manager entered into a Purchase Agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for the purchase of a police/dispatch radio console system; and

WHEREAS, with the dispatch center equipment upgrades, it is necessary to purchase replacement police/dispatch radio console furniture for Police Department operations; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter and state law, this Council has the authority by legislative enactment such as this Resolution to authorize a purchase of equipment through a competitive bid obtained through a cooperative purchasing program, which for this purchase is through General Services Administration (GSA) Contract No. GS-03F-030DA, with Wright Line, LLC providing said police/dispatch radio console furniture for the total price of \$44,354.39; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that the City enter into a contract with Wright Line, LLC for said furniture, and this Council has determined to authorize said contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Wright Line, LLC for the purchase of police/dispatch radio console furniture for the Police Department in an amount not to exceed Forty-Four Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Four Dollars and Thirty-Nine Cents (\$44,354.39), and the contract shall be in a form acceptable to the City Manager and City Solicitor.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Hudson by reason of the City's need to quickly replace the police/dispatch radio console furniture to ensure effective use of new radio equipment upgrades that were approved and ordered in 2019 and to ensure a timely transition to the new equipment; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members
