

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH B&C COMMUNICATIONS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A POLICE/DISPATCH RADIO MICROWAVE CONNECTION PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, implementation of the 2020 Dispatch Upgrade Project requires a microwave connection be established from the Hudson Police Department to the Twinsburg site of the Summit County-Akron 800MHz Regional Radio System; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends that B&C Communications be engaged by the City for unique and specialized equipment and professional services relating to the Police/Dispatch Radio Microwave Connection Project (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to accept the proposal from B&C Communications for Project implementation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into purchase agreement with B&C Communications for equipment and professional services relating to the implementation of the Project in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$69,625.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Hudson by reason of the City’s need to coordinate implementation of the microwave connection in a timely manner to ensure effective use of new radio equipment upgrades that were approved and ordered in 2019 and to ensure a timely transition to the new equipment; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
