Purpose & Explanation

The Hudson Fire Department is seeking funding assistance for the purchase of a washer-extractor with the capacity for four sets of turnout gear. The Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Program offers a 5-to-1 matching grant up to \$15,000. Equipment cost is \$11,351.00. The grant application is for \$9,459.17. The City of Hudson's match will be \$1,891.83.
