Through these fund-raising efforts, along with generous donations from Hudson League for Service, the Jim Hackney Foundation and the Burton Morgan Foundation, Hudson EMS received funding totaling \$16,000.

EMS Outreach of Hudson partnered with the Rotary Club of Hudson to fund the purchase of a Lucas Chest Compression System, valued at \$16,000, for Hudson EMS.
