Executive Summary: In the first quarter of 2017 City Council requested information on the feasibility of installing a solar power system to Hudson's municipal electric distribution system to help offset a portion of the City's overall power purchases. The City's electric system consultant Mr. John Courtney of Courtney & Associates will present information regarding the potential advantages of installing such

a system, the pricing we would expect to see per KWh, and the potential offsets in power,

transmission and capacity costs.
