Executive Summary: City Council will take action pertaining to City Manager Jane Howington's Employment Agreement.

Legislative History

Resolution No. 14-83, authorizing the Council President to enter into an Employment Agreement with Jane Howington as City Manager, passed July 8, 2014.

Resolution No. 15-138, authorizing an amendment to the Agreement, passed September 15, 2015.

Resolution No. 16-139, authorizing an amendment to the Agreement, passed August 16, 2016.

Purpose & Explanation

Based on Jane Howington's performance over the past year, Council desires to amend her employment agreement to provide a merit increase in salary and to award a bonus payment.

Timing Considerations

A salary adjustment will be retroactive to August 1, 2017, and a bonus will be payable on December 31, 2017.
