### Legislative History

Resolution No. 16-100, authorizing the City to purchase renewable energy certificates and to offer Hudson Public Power customers the option to participate in AMP's EcoSmart Choice Program, passed July 19, 2016.

### Purpose & Explanation

On February 27, 2018, AMP awarded and the City Manager's designee accepted 2017 Sustainability Grant funding in the amount of \$619.00. Staff seeks to use the EcoSmart Choice grant funding for energy and environmental education for Hudson Public Power customers. Energy-efficient items will be purchased for giveaways.
