AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 874.04 OF CHAPTER 874, "MOBILE FOOD VEHICLES," OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION CODE REGARDING THE LOCATION OF OPERATION FOR MOBILE FOOD VEHICLES: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Brief Description: This Ordinance amends the City's Business Regulation Code to allow licensed mobile food vehicles to operate within 500-feet of a brick and mortar restaurant when the licensed mobile food vehicle is part of an approved temporary special event pursuant to Chapter 872.

Legislative History

Resolution No. 19-182, establishing a temporary (90-day) moratorium on enforcement of Section 874.04 (b) of the Business Regulation Code related to location for operation of Mobile Food Vehicles; passed December 10, 2019.

Purpose & Explanation

Currently, the City's Business Regulations prohibit a mobile food vehicle from operating within 500 feet of a brick and mortar restaurant even when the mobile food vehicle is operating as a part of a previously approved temporary special event. The proposed legislation seeks to carve out an exception to the 500-foot ban and allow mobile food vehicles that are a part of a previously approved temporary special event to operate within 500 feet of a brick and mortar restaurant.
