To ensure continuity of legal services for the City, the City Manager would like to appoint long-time legal advisor (and past City Solicitor) of the City of Hudson, R. Todd Hunt of Walter Havefield LLP, as the City's interim City Solicitor while the City conducts a search for the next City Solicitor.
