

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ALLOW DOOR2ART TO INSTALL ON THE CITY GREENS A BIRDSONG ART INSTALLATION IN 2026.

WHEREAS, previously, the City approved a request by the Door 2 Art Studio for a temporary art installation that featured approximately 100 artist-created plastic birds that hung in trees on the downtown Greens, creating an art walk intended to help generate foot traffic to the downtown; and

WHEREAS, Door 2 Art Studio has presented a new proposal seeking to display a subset of the original quantity of small, 3-D birds on the Park Lane Green for an estimated period of July through October, 2026; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to support the arts and draw foot traffic to downtown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to do all things necessary to allow the Door 2 Art Studio to install a temporary display of private art upon the City Greens in furtherance of the “Birdsong Public Art Project” between July and October 2026. For the avoidance of doubt, the City Manager has the discretion to negotiate and sign any required agreements and may require any and all measures necessary to protect the City from any potential threats or liability.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
