

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE FLEET VEHICLE FOR PUBLIC WORKS OPERATIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson maintains a fleet of vehicles to support the operations of its Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of fleet vehicles is necessary to ensure reliable and efficient service delivery, minimize maintenance costs, and enhance operational performance; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle being replaced is a 2012 F-550 with a dump bed in the Service operational area of the Public Works Department that has reached the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, funds have been appropriated in the City's budget for the replacement of said vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle being replaced was budgeted in the 2025 fleet replacement budget and is being acquired using cooperative purchasing pricing; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract for the replacement of a Hudson Public Works fleet vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, for the purchase of one (1) fleet vehicle for use in the Public Works Service Department in an amount up to \$115,000.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
