A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A COST REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH WESTERN RESERVE ACADEMY FOR INSTALLATION OF PARALLEL PARKING ALONG E. PROSPECT STREET.

WHEREAS, Western Reserve Academy ("WRA") reached out to the City and requested the installation of three (3) parallel, public parking spaces along E. Prospect Street between State Route 91 and College Street (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, because the three (3) new, parallel parking spaces along E. Prospect Street between State Route 91 and College Street are for public use only, as noted above, they shall not be restricted to use by employees, representative or guests of WRA or any other private use; and

WHEREAS, because the three (3) new, parallel parking spaces along E. Prospect Street between State Route 91 and College Street are for public use only, as noted above, no private or non-City of Hudson signs restricting or attempting to restrict their use shall be erected in the vicinity of the spaces without the approval of City Council; and

WHEREAS, WRA has agreed to reimburse the City for this Project, which would be installed as part of the City's 2024 Asphalt Resurfacing Program, at a cost of \$18,928.25, which includes a 10% contingency; and

WHEREAS, the Project is in the City and its residents' best interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Manager is authorized to enter into a cost reimbursement agreement with WRA in connection with the installation of the three (3) new, parallel public parking spaces as a part of the Project.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Manager and City Engineer are authorized to do all things necessary to construct the public parking spaces, implement the Project and the cost reimbursement agreement.

<u>Section 3.</u> The above recitals are fully incorporated herein.

<u>Section 4.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
