

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 25-182 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO INCREASE AN EXISTING PURCHASE ORDER FOR ACUSHNET GOLF EQUIPMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 25-182 authorized the City Manager to advertise for bids or to utilize various charter-authorized governmental competitive purchasing programs and enter into contracts for construction, supplies, services and equipment, including equipment and materials to be sold at Ellsworth Meadows Golf Club; and

WHEREAS, Ellsworth Meadows Golf Club has experienced an increase in golf sales since the opening of the new clubhouse, course improvements and year-round operations, generating positive sales margins for the City; and

WHEREAS, due to an increase in golf sales, inventory is being depleted and acquisition costs are approaching the original approved amount for Acushnet golf equipment; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue providing products to patrons at the Club's pro-shop, an increase in the originally approved funding is necessary; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City to increase the additional funding for merchandise to be sold at the Ellsworth Meadows Golf Club, especially during the summer months.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. That Resolution No. 25-159 is hereby amended to increase the authorization in the existing purchase order for Acushnet golf equipment from \$50,000 to \$100,000.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of life, property, public health, safety, public peace, and the general welfare of the City and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to enter this agreement in a timely fashion due to seasonal needs and market and offer conditions; wherefore, this legislation shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage, provided it receives five (5) affirmative votes of members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes are required if all members are present; otherwise it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
