AN ORDINANCE CREATING A FIRE STATION RENOVATION FUND (421).

WHEREAS, in order to improve safety and the lives, health, and property of Hudson residents, the City has begun the process of designing and renovating the City Fire / EMS station; and

WHEREAS, a separate City fund to track the funding, debt (bond) proceeds, and construction costs of the renovations is necessary and proper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. That the Fire Station Renovation Fund (421) is hereby established.
- Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
