

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR THE 2026
CAPITAL MAINTENANCE PROGRAMS OF THE CITY OF HUDSON.**

WHEREAS, the City administration seeks to advertise, bid and award contracts for the City's 2026 Annual Capital Maintenance Program; and

WHEREAS, 2026 Annual Capital Maintenance Program includes: line striping; crack sealing; concrete replacement and/or repair; catch basin repairs; and asphalt resurfacing and patching; and

WHEREAS, as award of these projects will be based upon the approved 2026 capital budget; and

WHEREAS, the 2026 Annual Capital Maintenance Program is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of bids for the purpose of seeking the lowest and best bidder for the City's 2026 Annual Capital Maintenance Program, in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's office.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to award, enter, and then implement contracts for the 2026 Annual Capital Maintenance Program of the City of Hudson, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefore, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids, and the approval as to form and correctness by the City Solicitor.

Section 3. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract if deemed necessary to do so.

Section 4. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
