

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDED AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO RAIL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION FOR THE HINES HILL ROAD GRADE SEPARATION PROJECT THROUGH THE OHIO GRADE CROSSING ELIMINATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Grade Crossing Elimination Program, administered by the Ohio Rail Development Commission (“ORDC”), provides funding to assist local communities in eliminating hazardous railroad crossings; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the City’s Hines Hill Road Grade Separation Project, the City was originally awarded a grant from the ORDC in the amount of \$2,886,174; and

WHEREAS, ORDC recently awarded the City additional contingency funds for the Project, bringing the total grant amount to \$4,290,000; and

WHEREAS, the Project’s total cost is estimated at \$19.5 million; and

WHEREAS, the Hines Hill Grade Separation Project is in the best interest of the City, its residents, and the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter and do all things necessary to implement an amended grant agreement with Ohio Rail Development Commission in order to accept the additional grant funds for the Hines Hill Road Grade Separation Project.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
