

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 25-54, A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT FOR SUMMER FIREWORKS IN 2025, 2026, AND 2027; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson, in partnership with Hudson Community Foundation, has a tradition of hosting annual summer fireworks displays for the enjoyment of residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 25-54, the City entered into a three-year contract with American Fireworks for summer fireworks displays during 2025, 2026, and 2027; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Hudson Community Foundation agree that a larger, special display is fitting and proper during 2026 in light of the nation's 250th anniversary; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$25,000 for the 2026 display is required and will be paid by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. That Resolution No. 25-54 is hereby amended to authorize the City Manager to execute a three-year contract with American Fireworks that includes \$25,000 increase for the cost of the 2026 display in order to honor the nation's 250th anniversary.

Section 2. That the City Manager is authorized to enter an agreement with American Fireworks as described herein (so long as it replaces the previously executed agreement) and to otherwise do all things necessary to implement the terms and intentions of this Resolution.

Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the timely submission of the necessary paperwork in order secure the specified pricing due to market conditions and to meet the required deadline, and shall, therefore, be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives an affirmative vote of at least six (6) members of the Council for its enactment if seven (7) are present, or an affirmative vote of at least five (5) members if only five (5) or six (6) members are present at the meeting at which

it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
