DETERMINING THE METHOD OF GIVING PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE ENACTMENT OF ORDINANCES AND THE ADOPTION OF RESOLUTIONS AND OF ANY OTHER ACTS OF COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Section 3.05, Paragraph (c) of the Charter of the Village of Hudson, provides that the Council may by ordinance determine the method of giving public notice of the enactment of its ordinances, and the adoption of its resolutions and of any other of its acts or proceedings which it deems proper to publish, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio;

Section 1:

That all municipal ordinances, resolutions, statements, orders, proclamations, notices and reports required by law or ordinance to be published, shall be published in one newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Hudson for the following times:

Ordinances, resolutions, proclamations of elections, once a week for two consecutive weeks; provided, however, such ordinances and resolutions shall be published by title only unless Council by motion requires otherwise.

Notices, not less than two weeks nor more than four weeks.

All other matters shall be published once.

Section 2:

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and for the daily operation of a municipal department, by providing the criteria for the publication of ordinances and resolutions and other matters requiring publication, and by reason thereof shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage provided it receives five (5) votes of the members of Council elected thereto; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
