

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR CUSTOMER SUPPORT SOFTWARE WITH CALIX, INC.

WHEREAS, the City previously entered a three-year agreement with Calix, Inc. for the purchase of equipment and professional support services for Velocity Broadband; and

WHEREAS, given the residential Fiber to the Home effort, an enhancement and update to the software services the City receives is now warranted as a new professional services contract with Calix, Inc. will allow residents access to additional security features, give customers the ability to better monitor their Velocity equipment, and provide Velocity staff with enhanced notifications, more granular security controls, and additional automation tools that reduce staff troubleshooting time; and

WHEREAS, Calix is the current vendor used by Velocity Broadband and whose equipment is already being utilized at customers' premises; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to enter an additional contract with Calix, Inc. for certain system upgrades.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager and/or his designee are hereby authorized to enter a professional services contract with Calix, Inc. for additional customer support software, in accordance with the terms and conditions deemed necessary and appropriate by the City Manager or his designee as described herein and in compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

Section 2. The City Manager is further authorized to take all necessary actions, including the execution of any required documents, upon approval as to form by the City Solicitor, to implement the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
