A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A DISPATCH SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF PENINSULA, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Village of Peninsula has approached the City of Hudson to continue working with the City as to dispatch services for the Village; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson desires to contract with the Village of Peninsula for dispatch services; and

WHEREAS, the Hudson Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) will provide 24-hour, seven days per week dispatching services for the Peninsula Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Manager and/or his designee are authorized to enter an agreement with the Village of Peninsula for dispatch services. The agreement shall be in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and in a form satisfactory to and approved by the City Solicitor.

Section 2: The above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.

<u>Section 3:</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4:</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
