

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE VETERAN'S WAY RETAINING WALL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, City staff has recently identified that an existing block retaining wall, originally constructed with the Milford Road Connector Project in 2005, has begun to deteriorate and is in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, more specifically, the wall, located near the Veterans' Way bridge over the railroad, at 61 Milford Road, is deteriorating due to runoff, weather, and other factors; and

WHEREAS, this repair project is currently being designed by Osborn Engineering; and

WHEREAS, the estimated project cost of construction is \$225,000, which includes contingency; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to conduct this project and complete this repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise for a period of three (3) weeks on the City of Hudson website requesting the submission of bids for the purpose of acquiring the lowest and best bidder in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Manager's office for the Veterans' Way Retaining Wall Project.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter and do all things necessary to implement a contract with the lowest and best bidder on the Veteran's Way Retaining Wall Project, so long as it is in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor and subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor.

Section 3. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders.

Section 4. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
