GENERAL PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT (ONGOING)

Ongoing opportunities for engagement in several online and in-person formats in addition to the scheduled events below. Project website with digital polls & comments; self-guided walking tours; staff office hours; engagements with staff at community events; etc.

Design

Community Boards & Organizations Charrette | *Invite-Basis* (June 10)

Complete charrette design exercise; small groups create several draft plans, & the full group reviews. Expected to include leadership of more than 60 Hudson boards and organizations. The public is welcome to attend and observe; however, participation in the June 10th charrette session is limited to the invited community representatives to achieve a cross-section of organizations.

Resident Charrettes | *Registration-Basis* (June 17)

Complete charrette design exercise; small groups create several draft plans, & the full group reviews. Two (2) sessions are to be offered at different times of day to encourage attendance. The public is welcome to attend and observe; however, participation in the June 17th charrettes is limited to registered residents (accommodations for walk-ins are not guaranteed). **Registration required.**

Council Subcommittee (June 23, Tuesday)

Charrette Summary Presentation & Open House (July 1)

Consultant presents the rough concepts created at all three (3) charrettes, followed by an open house for public comments to determine preferred concepts that should be refined into draft plans. *No registration required.*

Revise

Public Open House #1: Input on Draft Concept Plans (July 22)

Open house for public to review three (3) concept plans with cost estimates. One (1) overall preferred plan is determined based on public rankings and input, with additional input collected about the preferred features from each plan. *No registration required.*

Refine

Council Subcommittee (August 7, Friday)

Public Open House #2: Input on a Revised Concept Plan (Aug 22)

Open house for public to review one (1) revised plan with cost estimates, 3D modeling and watercolor (this plan will be a revised version of 1 plan from the previous open house, but may incorporate components from each concept plan based on the features that residents preferred the most). *No registration required.*
