A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR A PREFABRICATED PUBLIC RESTROOM STRUCTURE FOR THE OAK GROVE PARK INCLUSIVE PLAYGROUND.

WHEREAS, in connection with the ongoing Inclusive Playground effort, the City seeks to purchase and install prefabricated concrete public restroom structures at Oak Grove Park through CXT Concrete Buildings; and

WHEREAS, this restroom facility will have running water and flushable toilets for guests using the park, including those requiring assistance for children and adults with special assistance requirements; and

WHEREAS, the purchase would be completed through the Sourcewell Contract #052725, an authorized State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program, which entity employs competitive bidding processes for equipment, satisfying the requirements for competitive bidding under the Ohio Revised Code and City law; and

WHEREAS, the Inclusive Playground project is important to the community and this purchase is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager and his designee are hereby authorized to enter into a purchase and installation contract with CXT Concrete Buildings for the purchase of a prefabricated concrete restroom structure to be installed at Oak Grove Park, not to exceed the amount of \$125,00.00.
- Section 2. The City Manager and Finance Director are hereby authorized to spend up to \$125,000 budget authorization for said equipment.
 - Section 3. That the above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.
- Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
