### ***Special Recognition of America Recycles Day***

**WHEREAS**, America Recycles Day is about spreading the word on how recycling helps us reduce waste, save energy, and conserve precious resources; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States generates about 292 million tons of municipal solid waste annually, or more than 4.9 pounds per person per day; and

**WHEREAS**, in an effort to focus the nation's attention on the importance of further improving our recycling efforts, businesses, industries, government agencies, nonprofit organizations, and individuals have joined together to celebrate America Recycles Day and to encourage their friends, neighbors, and coworkers to learn more about recycling options in their community and commit to recycle more materials; and
