A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS, RESURFACING PROGRAM FUNDS, AND TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET ASIDE FUNDING PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY TO CONSTRUCT THE VARIOUS PROJECTS LISTED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, the City administration is planning numerous road resurfacing and other infrastructure projects, all of which could be supported by various federal grant funds and programs administered by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study ("AMATS"); and,

WHEREAS, the City is planning the following six specified projects ("Projects"), which qualify for the listed grant programming:

Resurfacing Grant:

- 1. Boston Mills Road Resurfacing (West Corp. Line to W. Streetsboro Street)
- 2. Hines Hill Road Resurfacing (West Corp. Line to Future Bridge Project Limit)

<u>Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG):</u>

- 3. Ravenna Street at Stow Road Roundabout
- 4. Barlow Road (west) at Terex Road (west) Turn Lane Addition
- 5. Darrow Road (State Route 91) Middleton Road to the City's North Corp. Line Signal & Turn Lane Improvements

<u>Transportation Alternatives Set Aside (TASA) Grant:</u>

6. Rails to Trails Trail Project – Barlow Road to Veterans Way (former Norfolk Southern Property)

WHEREAS, applications are due to AMATS by November 7, 2025, and the City would be informed if the project is funded in early 2026; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City and its residents to apply for grant funding on each of these projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager and his designees are hereby authorized to apply for the specified grant funding with AMATS for the Projects. Any grant and funding application-related actions by the City administration to date are hereby ratified and affirmed.

- <u>Section 2</u>. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>Section 4</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
