AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART TEN, "STREETS, UTILITIES AND PUBLIC SERVICES CODE" OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES, TO AMEND CHAPTER 1016 USE OF PUBLIC WAYS BY SERVICE PROVIDERS AND CABLE TELEVISION PROVIDERS.

WHEREAS, the City's Codified Ordinances regulate the use of public ways by service providers, being found in Chapter 1016, "Use Of Public Ways by Service Providers and Cable Television Providers;" and

WHEREAS, various contractors and users of the City's right-of-way have repeatedly failed to meet City standards in completing and finishing work; and

WHEREAS, various contractors and users of the City's right-of-way have repeatedly failed to respond to the City and residents' concerns over disruptions and incomplete work; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to amend Chapter 1016 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hudson to encourage and/or secure compliance and responsive behavior from those that use the City's right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. That Chapter 1016 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hudson be amended to provide as set forth in Exhibit "A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, with additions in <u>bold</u> and deletions being <u>stricken</u>.
- Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
