

79 DIVISION STREET

1889 brought a flurry of construction to the east end of Division Street. Lot 10, a previously undeveloped one and one-half acre tract, suddenly sprouted three new houses. Eliza Ellsworth, third wife and now widow of Ransom P. Ellsworth, had inherited the vacant land in 1883. Parcels were sold off for two new houses; Eliza herself built this one, a two story main core with a one and one-half story gabled ell on the west side. The side gabled wing has a shelf entablature at the entry.

Notice the decorative trim at the peak of the front gable and the handsome iron picket fence.

HH Lydia Finch House—1889

There is no local history on Lydia Finch other than the tax duplicate information that she built this house in 1889 and owned it until 1897. It is typical of the building style in Hudson during this time, with the dropped siding wall treatment and the Eastlake trim on the window casings. Most of the interior woodwork is original. A front porch has been enclosed.

In 1967, this was the home of Dr. Mary Anderson, a physician and a prominent figure in Ohio politics, active in the Women's Christian Temperance Union and the women's suffrage movement. She had a national reputation as a lecturer and was listed in the 1935 edition of *Who's Who Among American Women*.

Philip and Mary Elizabeth Wendling built this house; Philip was a butcher, born in Alsace and proprietor of a meat market on Main Street which was destroyed by the 1892 fire.

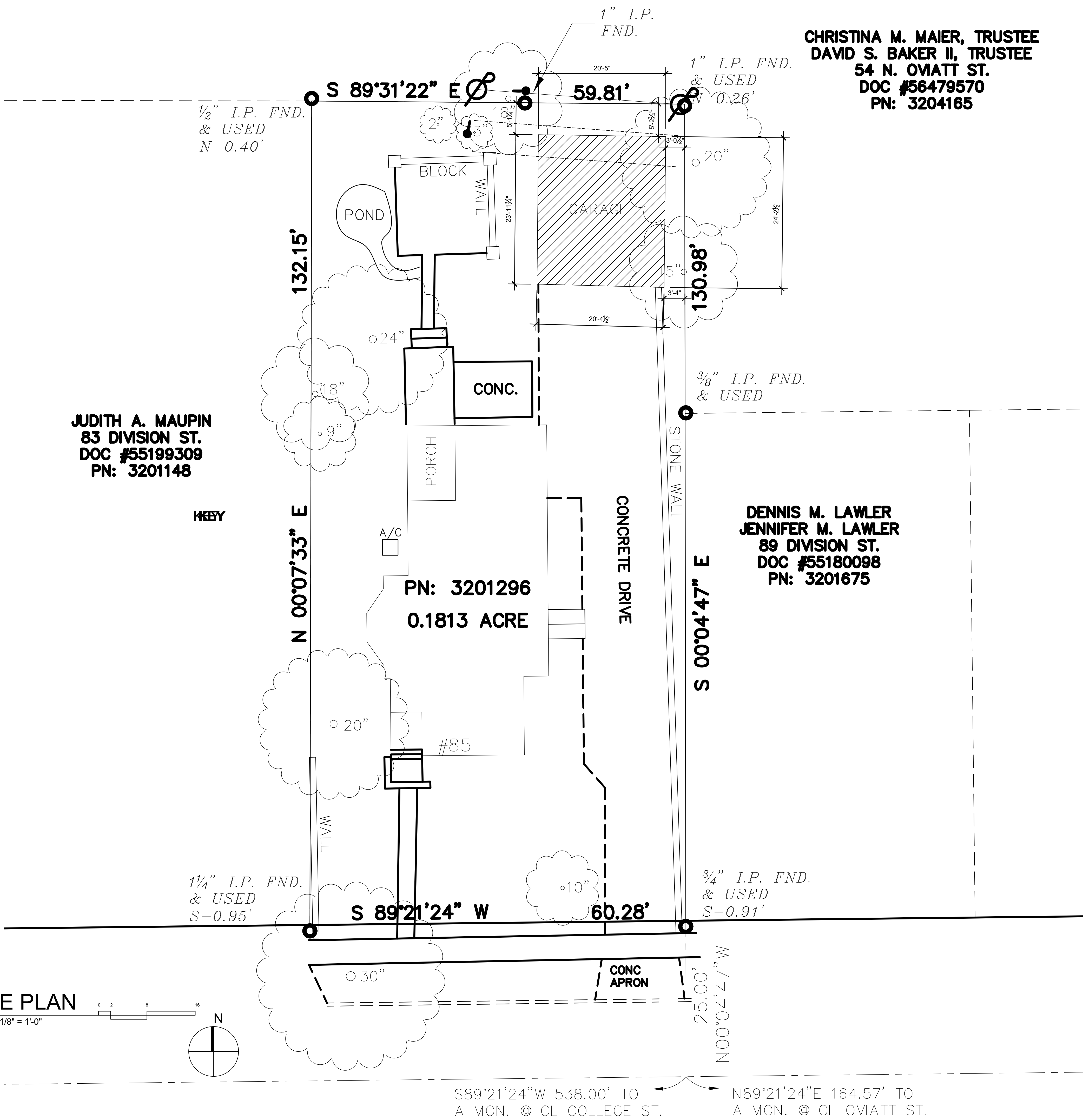
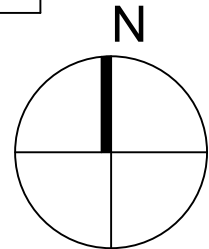
The basic structure is one widely used in the 1880-90 period. The ornamentation has been preserved above the doors and windows and around the front porch. The doors and windows have not been changed, and the roof over the porch is still the original patterned slate.

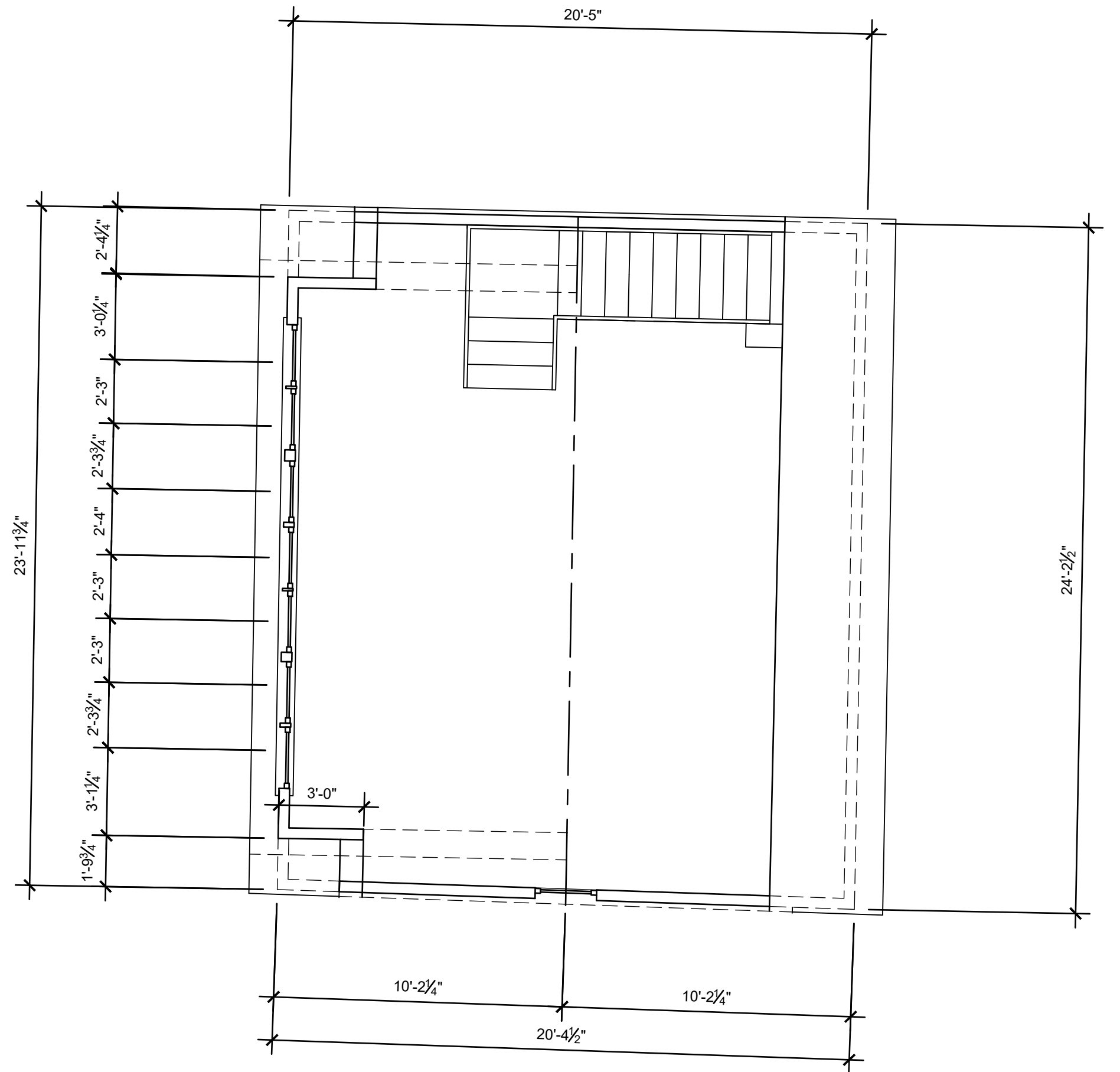
1 FIRST FLOOR PLAN

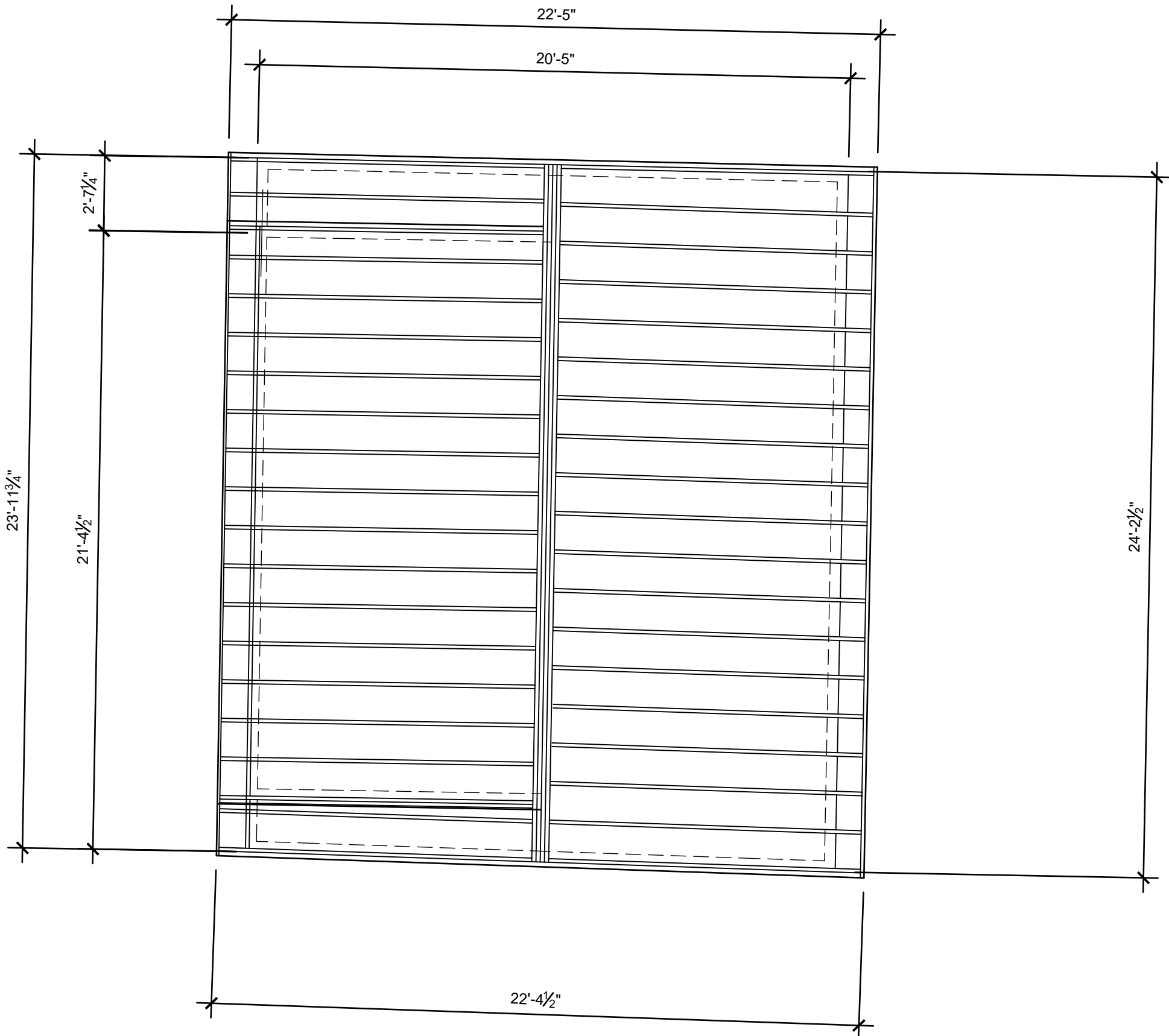
2 ATTIC FRAMING PLAN

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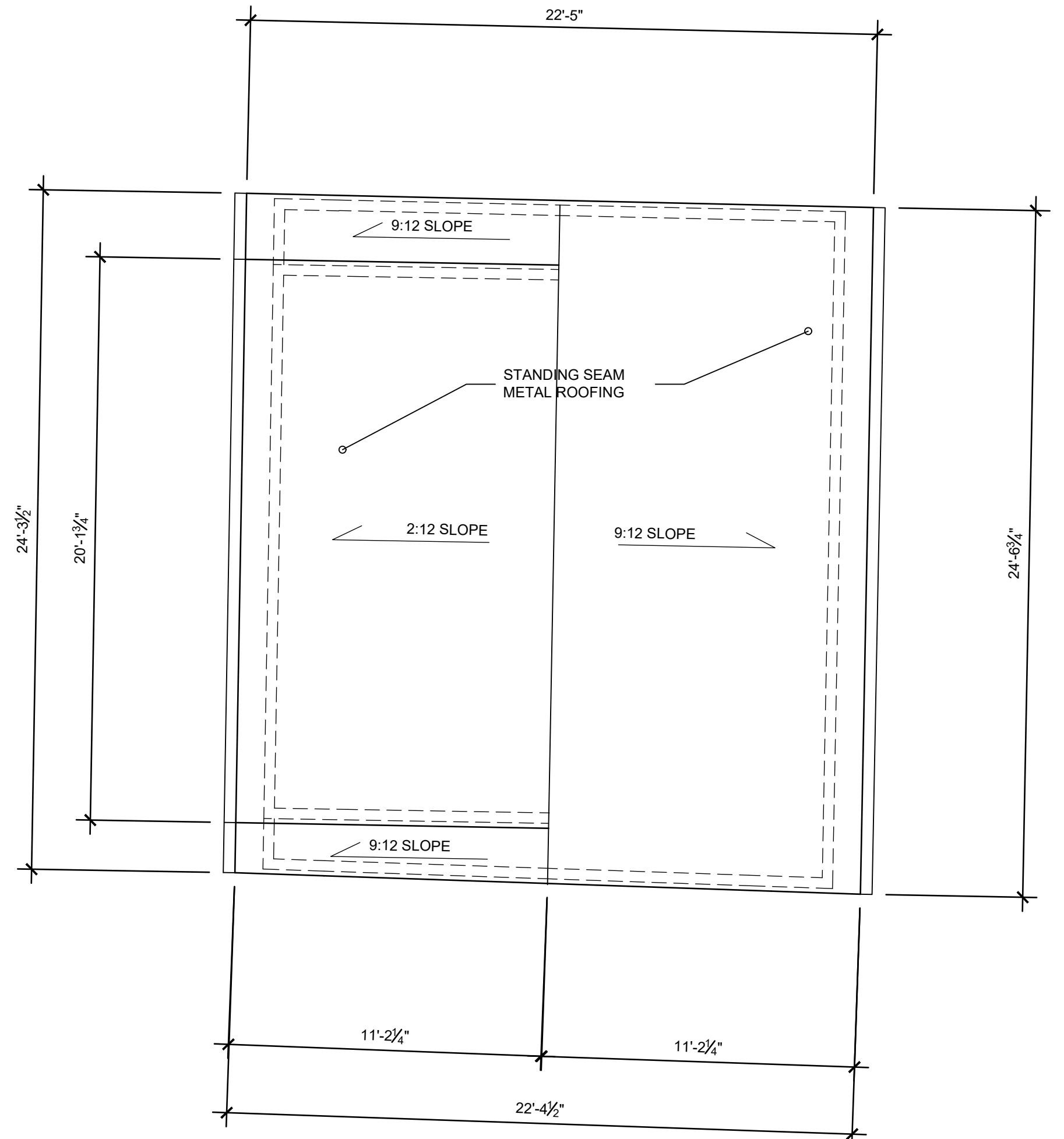
