General Comments:

C103 – Utility Plan

- 1. The water will be supplied from the existing watermains.
- 2. The plans will need approved by Summit County Sanitary Sewer Dept.
- 3. A stormwater pond is shown, full calculations will be needed.
 - a. Provide elevation of the Floodplain.
 - b. How will the proposed pond function with flood waters?

4. Do the downstream culverts have capacity with the pond discharge?

Additional Comments:

1. A trip generation report will be required.

2. Will the site be built in stages? The site will have minimal staging areas as construction proceeds.
