### ***Special Recognition of Red Kettle Day***

**WHEREAS**, the Salvation Army also maintains an Emergency Services capacity that stands ready to be deployed to Hudson in the event of a disaster; and

**WHEREAS**, the Salvation Army has a volunteer Service Unit in Hudson that functions as the gateway to both economic and material resources such as food, rental assistance, utility assistance, clothing, emergency shelter for the abused and access to child services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Salvation Army provides all of its services without fee or cost using only funds donated in Hudson.
