WHEREAS, the City of Hudson Ohio wishes to recognize the family's on-going community service in the memory of Vincent William Baran, who was so named after Saint Vincent de Paul, the Catholic patron saint of the poor; and

WHEREAS, The Mighty Vincent endeavors through the Hudson Community Foundation and the memory of Vincent William Baran shall continue to inspire us all to do good for each other both in our community and in our world; and
