A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE PERK COMPANY FOR THE SR 303 SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (SUM-SR 303, 12.63, PID#117269); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City intends to make improvements along West Streetsboro Street (State Route 303) between Boston Mills Road and Atterbury Blvd., and this project includes pavement striping, signage improvements, and curb ramps; and

WHEREAS, the construction total cost for this project is now \$162,971.56, with \$100,000 funded by a safety grant from the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT"); and

WHEREAS, the City received permission to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder on May 10, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the project scope was reduced from its initial design, and the current project includes pavement striping, signage improvements, and curb ramp work; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on August 5, 2025, with bids coming from the Perk Company in the amount of \$148,155.96 and Karvo Companies in the amount of \$157,795.19; and

WHEREAS, with Perk Company being the lowest and best bidder, the total project cost, including a 10% contingency, is \$162,971.56, with ODOT paying the maximum grant amount of \$100,000 and the City responsible for the remaining \$62,971.56; and

WHEREAS, as the original legislation approved a total cost of up to \$150,000, the City administration is seeking permission to increase the construction cost up to \$162,971.56; and,

WHEREAS, this project remains in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The City Manager is hereby to enter into a contract for the State Route 303 Safety Improvement Project with the Perk Company. The City Manager, the City Solicitor, and other appropriate officials are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary and proper actions to implement the terms of this Resolution and said contracts and/or agreements.
- Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the timely submission of the necessary paperwork in order to complete this project during good weather, to promote highway safety and/or immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the community and shall, therefore, be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives an affirmative vote of at least six (6) members of the Council for its enactment if seven (7) are present, or an affirmative vote of at least five (5) members if only five (5) or six (6) members are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
