

RESOLUTION NO. 23-____

OFFERED BY: MAYOR ANZEVINO

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE HUDSON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING INSIDE MILLAGE.

WHEREAS, inside millage up to 10 mills is available without voter approval for local use; and

WHEREAS, the City currently is allotted 3.57 mills, of which 3.1 mills flows to the general fund, and the Hudson City Schools are allotted 4.23 mills; and

WHEREAS, this proposal would shift 2 mills from the City's Allocation to the school district; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to have the ability to terminate the agreement with one-year notice.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Hudson City School District for the transfer of two mills of inside millage from the City's allotment to the School District, with the option to terminate with one year notice.

Section 2: That the above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
