**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT
GRANT FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF OHIO FOR AN ADA
ACCESSIBLE KAYAK RAMP.**

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson applied for grant funding through the State Capital Budget Grant to support regional and local projects that demonstrate a state benefit in higher education, mental health, parks and recreation, conservation, and cultural and sports facilities; and

WHEREAS, the installation of an ADA accessible boat/kayak launch dock at Hudson Springs Park, a popular destination within the Hudson Park System, will allow paddling activities to be enjoyed by individuals with disabilities, beginners, children, and seniors; and

WHEREAS, the project aligns to the current Park Master Plan and the Hudson Park Board's desire to focus on increased accessibility throughout the park system; and

WHEREAS, the grant does not require a local funding match, the grant amount of \$62,700.00 is expected to cover the full cost of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager and his designee are authorized to do all things necessary to accept a State Capital Budget Grant from the State of Ohio, including the execution of a grant agreement, for the construction of an ADA Accessible Kayak Ramp at Hudson Springs Park.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
