

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1, “PLAN SUBMISSIONS AND GENERAL NOTES,” OF CHAPTER 1419, “ENGINEERING STANDARDS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE CONSTRUCTION” OF THE BUILDING AND HOUSING CODE.

WHEREAS, in order to promote safety, public health, and the general welfare of the City and its residents, the City regulates new infrastructure construction in Chapter 1419 of the Codified Ordinances of Hudson, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the standards, rules, and regulations of Chapter 1419 of the Codified Ordinances are intended for quality and uniformity of public and private infrastructure improvements and complement other city, county, state, and federal standards; and

WHEREAS, in particular, Section 1 - Plan Submission and General Notes of the City of Hudson Engineering Standards for Infrastructure Construction was last updated in 2019; and

WHEREAS, this code should be updated and amended to reflect various changes in industry standards that have occurred since the last update; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. That Section 1, “Plan Submissions and General Notes,” of Chapter 1419, “Engineering Standards for Infrastructure Construction” of the Building and Housing Code, is hereby amended as provided in the attached Exhibit “A,” which is incorporated herein, with additions being in blue and underlined and deletions being in red and stricken through.

Section 2. Those provisions of Section 1, “Plan Submissions and General Notes,” of Chapter 1419, “Engineering Standards for Infrastructure Construction” of the Codified Ordinances of Hudson that were in effect prior to the effective date of this Ordinance and that are in conflict with Section 1 above of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and shall no longer have any effect to the extent that they are inconsistent with the amendments adopted in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance and restated here.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
