

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH CT CONSULTANTS, A VERDANTAS COMPANY, FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT FACILITY SOFTENER REHABILITATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the water softener tanks at the City's Water Treatment Plant are treating water at a rate significantly below the design flow; and

WHEREAS, the tanks have access constraints that limit inspection and maintenance needs; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks the development of plans and specifications to upgrade the City's Water Treatment Plants water softener tanks, including improvements for better access for future inspection and maintenance and improvements to promote higher flow rates; and

WHEREAS, the City staff solicited and received quotes from qualified engineering consultants familiar with water softener tank rehabilitation at water treatment plants; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has recommended CT Consultants to perform the requested services at its quote of \$34,500; and

WHEREAS, City staff is requesting a 10% contingency to handle any unforeseen issues that may arise during the design and investigation work on this project, bringing the total request to \$37,950.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager and/or his designee are hereby authorized to enter a professional services contract with CT Consultants, a Verdantas Company, for engineering design services for the water treatment plant facility softener rehabilitation project, all as more fully described in the City staff's Request for a Proposal or as the City Engineer may specify. The contract shall be in form approved by the City Solicitor.

Section 2. The aforesaid project is in the City and its residents' best interest.

Section 3. That the above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
