A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE STATE OF OHIO FOR 2024 DIVISION OF STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE TRAINING REIMBURSEMENT GRANT AND ACCEPTING FUNDS IF AWARDED.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Division of State Fire Marshal's Office awards grant funding for the purpose of state certified courses or Ohio Fire Academy (OFA) up to \$15,000 for eligible firefighter training courses; and

WHEREAS, the Hudson Fire Department has sought funding for eligible training under the 2024 Ohio Division of State Fire Marshal's Training Reimbursement Grant for up to \$15,000.00 from January 1, 2024, to December 31, 2024 and two members of the Fire Department have completed courses eligible under this grant; and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. That this Council supports and hereby affirms the City Manager's Designee's action in submitting an application to the 2024 Ohio Division of State Fire Marshal's Training Reimbursement Grant application to reimburse eligible training for firefighters meeting established criteria.
- Section 2. That in the event the City is awarded the grant, this Council hereby authorizes the City Manager and/or his designee to accept such award and do all things necessary to process and use such funding for the purposes set forth herein.
- Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
