AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING SHOOTING RANGES WITHIN THE CITY OF HUDSON AND AMENDING THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the City seeks to expand business opportunities within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to find ways to develop opportunities to train its police officers locally whenever possible; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to give its citizens new avenues to learn about responsible gun ownership and to hone their skills so that they can be safe, responsible gun owners; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio already regulates commercial and private shooting ranges throughout the State in a manner that relies upon nationally recognized safety standards; and

WHEREAS, no commercial shooting ranges currently exist within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to clarify its regulations on commercial shooting ranges to attract such businesses to the community to accomplish the above goals and otherwise promote the health, safety, and welfare of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- **Section 1**. That Section 1206.02(c) of the Codified Ordinances of Hudson be amended to establish subsection (35) as provided in Exhibit A:
- Section 2. That the table provided in Section 1206.01 of the Codified Ordinances of Hudson be amended to include a row for indoor shooting ranges and indicate that they are allowed as a conditional use in Zoning Districts 6, 8, and 9.
- Section 3. That Section 1205.09(c)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of Hudson, governing conditional uses in Zoning District 6, be amended to include subsection "H. Indoor shooting ranges."
- <u>Section 4</u>. That Section 1205.11(c)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of Hudson, governing conditional uses in Zoning District 8, be amended to include subsection "J. Indoor shooting ranges."
- <u>Section 5</u>. That Section 1205.12(c)(1) of the Codified Ordinances of Hudson, governing conditional uses in Zoning District 9, be amended to include subsection "O. Indoor shooting ranges."
- **Section 6**. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

Exhibit A

(Adding subsection (35) to C.O. 1206.02(c) without making any other additions, subtractions, or other amendments)

- (35) Special Conditions for Indoor Shooting Ranges:
- A. The use of the indoor shooting range shall, at minimum, comply with state and federal regulations relating to indoor shooting ranges.
- B. The use of the indoor shooting range shall, at minimum, conform with the standards required under State law under Ohio Revised Code Section 1533.84, as amended, and any related administrative code section.
- C. The use of the indoor shooting range shall be located a minimum of 500 feet from the lot line of any residentially zoned or used parcel.
- D. The use of the indoor shooting range shall be located a minimum of 500 feet from the lot line of any school.
- E. The use of the indoor shooting range shall be located a minimum of 500 feet from the lot line of another use of the same category.
 - F. The use of the indoor shooting range shall not occur prior to 7:00am nor after 9:00pm.
- G. The use of the indoor shooting range shall take care to effectively suppress noise to ensure it meets standards promulgated in C.O. 1207.10.
- H. The use of the indoor shooting range shall install backstops and bullet traps sufficient to prevent the escape of .50 caliber bullets, and such range shall not be permitted to allow the discharge of any round greater than .50 caliber in size or force.
- I. The use of the indoor shooting range shall be overseen by a properly licensed range safety officer.
- J. The use of the indoor shooting range shall take care to incorporate safety and design standards sufficient to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the community and location where the indoor shooting range is proposed.
- K. Prior to the issuance of a conditional use for an indoor firing range, the applicant must demonstrate full compliance with federal and state law, including, but not limited, to providing copies of all required licenses and certifications.
