The City of Hudson Engineering Department has reviewed the plans submitted and the comments are below. Note: The City of Hudson Engineering Standards (Engineering Standards) and Land Development Code (LDC) are available online at the City of Hudson Website www.hudson.oh.us under the Engineering Dept. and Community Development Department respectively. The City of Hudson Engineering Department has the following comments:

General Comments:

- 1. The wetland delineation shows all work is outside of the 50' wetland buffer.
- 2. No utilities will be installed as part of the improvements.
- 3. There shall be no staging of equipment, materials, or employee vehicles in the ROW except during the construction of the construction entrance. MOT shall be provided by the contactor and approved by the engineering department.
- 4. Sight distances in both directions have been calculated and are acceptable.
- 5. The disturbed area will be approximately a tenth of an acre. No NOI is required and stormwater storage has been provided adjacent to the entrance.
- 6. A tree survey was completed and trees noted for removal with an X on the drawing.
- 7. The site will be maintained by the Park's Department.
- 8. There are no sidewalks planned as part of these improvements.
