A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, FOR AN EMS PRIORITY ONE TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT GRANT ON BEHALF OF HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND ACCEPTING, IF AWARDED.

WHEREAS, City staff is seeking funding from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, through an EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant to fund training and/or equipment; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the State Board of Emergency Medical, Fire, and Transportation Services Grant Program is to improve and enhance EMS and trauma patient care in Ohio through the provision of grant funding for equipment, training, and research; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, the City will accept the grant funding and use it for the intended purposes to enhance the services provided by Hudson Emergency Medical Services; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be determined in June based on the amount of funding available for the program, with no matching funds required from the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1. That this Council hereby supports, ratifies and retroactively affirms the City Manager's designee's action in submitting an application to the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services for an EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant on behalf of Hudson Emergency Medical Services, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.
- Section 2. That in the event the City is awarded the grant, the City Manager and/or his designee are hereby authorized to accept such an award and do all things necessary to process and use such funding for the purposes set forth herein and consistent with the program's guidelines.
- Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
