

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND THE PURCHASE PRICE OF A LARGE CAPACITY ROUGH MOWER LISTED IN “EXHIBIT A” OF RESOLUTION NO. 24-149 DUE TO A LESSOR TRADE IN ALLOWANCE THAN EXPECTED.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 24-149, the City approved certain purchases, including a large capacity rough mower for the Ellsworth Golf Course, which is to be purchased through an approved and authorized through a State Term Schedule maintained by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services, satisfying the requirements for competitive bidding under the Ohio Revised Code and City law; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the purchase of the rough mower, the City was submitting equipment as a trade-in to help offset some of the purchase price; and

WHEREAS, unfortunately, the trade-in value given to the City on the equipment was lower than anticipated; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the lower-than-expected trade-in value, the City Administration is requesting an increase of \$3,272.49 over the previously approved \$85,000 for the purchase of a large capacity rough mower at the golf course; and

WHEREAS, this mower is needed for the 2025 mowing season; and

WHEREAS, this Council has appropriated the funds necessary for the purchase of said equipment to replace equipment in the Public Works Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to amend the purchase agreement for the large capacity rough mower with in an amount not to exceed \$88,272.49, so long as said amount has been appropriated in the City budget and the agreement is in a form approved by the City Solicitor.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
